### You're Fine, I'm Fine, We're All Fine: Building Mental Health Infrastructure in Your Workplace

The statistics tell a clear story. Mental health concerns for both adults and adolescents have grown significantly since 2018, and the need for support has only grown more since the pandemic. With the support of their City Council, the City of Montgomery began a mental health initiative for staff and the community. As a small local government, providing mental health treatment was not feasible. However, Montgomery believes that being a conduit to connect people with the help they need is a moral obligation.

This session will **provide information and resources for getting a mental health program off the ground for the staff and community in your jurisdiction.**

The presenters will be Montgomery **City Manager Brian Riblet** and **Assistant City Manager Tracy Henao**.
