Candidate Categories:

- **Lateral Candidates:** Current full-time State of Ohio Peace Officers or Ohio State Highway Patrol Troopers with at least one (1) year of full-time police *road* patrol experience. Higher starting salary and vacation credit may apply.
- **Non-Lateral Candidates:** Applicants with a current OPOTA Peace Officer Certification and less than one (1) year of full-time police road patrol experience, **or** those who will obtain an OPOTA Peace Officer Certification prior to appointment. It is the candidate's responsibility to obtain the required certification before appointment.
