This role involves performing a wide range of labor tasks to support the maintenance and operations of city infrastructure. The ideal candidate will be a dependable team player who communicates effectively, follows instructions well, and contributes positively to a collaborative work environment. The Public Works Department proudly serves the Wyoming community, home to approximately 8,500 residents, and plays a vital role in maintaining the high quality of life our city is known for. The Seasonal Maintenance Worker primarily performs outdoor work. Regular working hours are Monday-Friday, 7: 00 am-4:00 pm, with a summer schedule of 6:00 am-2:30 pm, operating Memorial Day through Labor Day. Varied schedules may be accommodated upon request. Examples of work include but are not limited to:

- Mowing/trimming
- Street maintenance
- Athletic field maintenance
- Landscaping/Watering flowers
- Trash collection from City facilities and grounds
- Leaf collection
- Clearing snow and ice from walkways and access points to City facilities
- Other similar work as assigned
- Successful candidates must be able to operate various landscaping equipment such as mowers, trimmers, blowers, etc.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Valid State driver's license maintained throughout course of employment with the city.
- Punctual and regular attendance required.
- Possess a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- Must have the ability and willingness to learn to safely operate all City vehicles, equipment, and tools.
- An oral interview, drug test, and background investigation must be passed by successful candidate.
